PERMIT TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION, MANNER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of a portion of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 75356 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 75356 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 47265, 75228, 75880, 75944, 75945, 75946, 75963, 76040, 76217, 76334, 76339, 76359 and 76779, having the same point of diversion, shall not exceed 1.311 cubic feet per second and 329.01 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The permittee shall report to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis the effect of pumping the well under this permit on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit. Any pumping of water under this permit may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit, unless the holder of this permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for municipal purposes to provide service to the parcels identified by the Nye County Assessor as APN's 38-784-07 and 38-871-20.

Any dedication of water from this permit for residential service shall be allocated at the tiered dedication rate prescribed, by letter dated November 4, 2008, by the State Engineer. The State Engineer may amend this dedicated allocation based on evidence and supporting data.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0016 cubic feet per second or 0.82 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 9, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




