**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 73717 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 73717 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Temporary Permits 76853T and 76855T, having the same point of diversion and a comingled place of use, shall not exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second and 1280 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permittee will measure water levels in the wells currently under Permits 43011, 43016, 63102, 63103, 76853T, 76854T, 76855T and 74610. Any change of the wells to be measured must be noticed to this office in writing prior to the change.

Permittee will measure water levels prior to irrigation in the spring, at the mid point of irrigation during the summer and at the end of irrigation in the fall. Any winter irrigation to be noticed to this office, in writing, prior to the change.

Permittee will submit an annual report of the water levels for said wells and pumpage data for wells operated by the permittee on or before January 31 for the prior year.

The reports are to be cumulative with historical data and will contain one (1) well per page with the seasonal water level measurement and monthly pumpage data.

The monitoring plan to be re-evaluated prior to the fourth year of irrigation.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 2.70 cubic feet per second or 640.0 acre-feet annually.**


