APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66717 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66717 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 76941 and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 2240.0 acre-feet per season for the irrigation of 560.0 acres. The permit holder is responsible for insuring delivery of the entitled decree and storage waters that are supplemental to this permit. In any year the Walker River Irrigation District declares a full allocation of decreed water to the priority years of C-125 decree claim 133 supplemental to this permit, underground water shall not be pumped from the well described in this permit. In any year the Walker River Irrigation District has no decreed or storage water, or declares a reduced allocation of surface waters to the priority years of C-125 decree claim 133 supplemental to this permit, then water can be pumped from wells for irrigation of the permitted place of use. Irrigation shall not exceed four acre-feet per acre from the total of decreed, storage and underground waters.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The period of use of this permit is 245 days from March 1 to October 31.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 5.2 cubic feet per second or 2240.0 acre-feet seasonally.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 21, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 21, 2012

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 21, 2012
