APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 36511, Certificate 16075, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 36511, Certificate 16075 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62767, 72193, 72194, 72195, 72372, 76953, 76956, 76958 and a portion of 76960 (being 7.2 AF) shall not exceed 33.246 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The permittee shall report to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis the effect of pumping the well under this permit on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit. Any pumping of water under this permit may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit, unless the holder of this permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0446 cubic feet per second or 5.806 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



The applicant, **Douglas County, PO Box 218 of Minden, NV 89423**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 36511 (Certificate 16075)**.

1. The source of water is: **an underground source.**
2. The amount of water to be changed: **0.0446 cfs (5.806 afa / 1.892 mga).**
3. The water to be used for: **(No Change).**
4. The water heretofore used for: **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic.**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point: **(No Change).**
6. The existing point of diversion is located within: **the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 12 North, Range 21 East, M. D. B. & M.; or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 18 bears S 36° 41' 20" W, a distance of 124.70 feet. (Fairgrounds Well).**

8. Existing place of use: **See attached Exhibit "B". See also map on file with State DWR under Permit 36511.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works: (Under the provision of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.)
12. Estimated cost of works: **Approximately \$1,133,000.**
13. Estimated time required to construct works: **Completed: Existing well to 380-feet, totalizing meter, pump, motor, storage tank, and approximately 4.08 miles of water distribution line.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: **10 years.**
15. Remarks: **A waterline construction project (SIP-00509) was just completed, connecting the Fairgrounds water system to the Sunrise Estates water system, and the Old Sawmill Industrial Park / Pete Beekhof development. In order for Douglas County to utilize the water rights in the Fairgrounds well on the other water systems in the area (Sunrise Estates and the Old Sawmill Industrial Park), the water under this application is being placed onto an expanded place of use, which includes the Fairgrounds water system, the Sunrise Estates water system, and the Old Sawmill Industrial Park / Pete Beekhof development. This Application to Change the Place of Use is to reflect the 2006 Master Plan.**
