**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30059, Certificate 10111 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30059, Certificate 10111 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 30059,30061,40201,40203, and 77093T shall not exceed 2635 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, not to exceed 2.764 cubic feet per second or 634.55 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:


