APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 70429 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 70429 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 70429, 70430, 74094, 74095, 77337T, 77338T, and 77339T shall not exceed 4,600 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second or 250.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

The purpose of this application is to change the point of diversion under Permit 70429 (CSI Well #2) to the point of diversion under Permit 74095 (CSI Well #4) on a temporary basis, not to exceed one (1) year, during the period in which Well #2 is out of service for the purpose of installing permanent equipment and interconnection with CSI Well #1. This temporary change is necessary to ensure a sufficient water supply to meet the construction and development water requirements of the Coyote Springs Master Planned Community while CSI Wells #1 and #2 are out of service for the installation of permanent equipment and facility interconnection.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

In the event CSI Well #2 is returned to service before expiration of the temporary permit CSI will relinquish the temporary permit and restore the point of diversion to the point described in 70429.
