APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of Steamboat Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 52317, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claims 678/679, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Measuring devices shall be designed and a monitoring plan shall be submitted to and approved by the State Engineer prior to filing the proof of completion of work. No return flow credit water for subdivisions will be approved from this permit until data supporting the use have been approved by this office.

This permit is issued subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

By issuance of this permit, the supplemental storage rights described under Truckee River Decree Claims 660 and 662 can no longer be used at the original existing place of use under Claims 678/679.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.049 cubic feet per second or 8.73 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 23, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 23, 2012
