APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of Deadman's Canyon Creek and Tributaries as heretofore granted under Proof V02752 as it appears in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Deadman's Canyon Creek and Its Tributaries in District Court of the Second Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Washoe, is issued subject to the terms, conditions, and irrigation period imposed in said decree, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 76815, 77541, and 77542 shall not exceed 148.95 acre-feet for the irrigation of 33.1 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.828 cubic feet per second or 148.95 acre-feet per season, and not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre from any and all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2011


