### PERMIT TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION, MANNER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under claim of vested right V06822, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said claim of vested right, V06822 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 57805, Certificate 14480; Permit 59294, Certificate 15611; Permit 59295, Certificate 15612; Permit 62334, Certificate 15613; Permit 62335, Certificate 15614; Permit 62336, Certificate 15615; Permit 62337, Certificate 15616; Permits 68928 and 77611 shall not exceed 162.01 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of the permit under Application Number 77611 will require any wells drilled under claim of vested right V06822 to be plugged in accordance with the Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 534.420 "Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling" within 60 days from the issuance of this permit. Failure to plug the well(s) will result in further administrative action by the State Engineer.

This permit is issued subject to any final determination under the claim of vested right V06822 as established in an adjudication of the source.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.22 cubic feet per second or 50.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

**August 7, 2010**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

**August 7, 2012**

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

**August 7, 2012**

Water being changed by this application will be used for recreational purposes within a series of ski lakes that are located within the proposed place of use. Currently, two completed ski lakes exist. A smaller third ski lake, which is located between the other two completed lakes, is being expanded/developed. Water has been placed to beneficial use within the third pond/ski lake under Permit 68928, however applicant wishes to expand this recreational pond/lake. Water under this application will be used throughout the ski lakes in conjunction with Permits 57805 Cert.14480, 59294 Cert.15611, 59295 Cert.15612, 62334-62337 Certs.15613-15616, respectively, and 68928.


16. Miscellaneous remarks:
