APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 57838, Certificate 15993, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 57838, Certificate 15993 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits, 71234, 72917, 72918, 73204, 73431, 73432, 74679, 75105, 75107, 77469T, 77621T, 77622T, 77623T, 77624T and 77625T shall not exceed 1127.452 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The water use for construction purposes under Temporary Permits 77469T, 77621T through 77625T, inclusive, must be metered separately from any other uses.

The well from which water will be diverted is being used with permission from the well owner, Barrick Ruby Hill Mine. Water will be developed from six existing wells and piped to a stand where it will be transported to the the place of use via water trucks. Filed concurrently herewith are four other temporary applications to change 62 acre-feet of permit 57838. In addition, the Applicant previously filed Application 77469T. Applicant requests that the total combined duty of all six applications to change shall be limited to 62 acre-feet.
