APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of a spring source as heretofore granted under Permit 10058, Certificate 3592, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 10058, Certificate 3592 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water from this well under Permit 61095, Certificate 15445 and Permit 77982 shall not exceed 2.914 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.



The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

THE NEW FACILITY WILL ACCOMODATE UP TO 10 USFS STAFF FROM MARCH - NOVEMBER, AND 2 STAFF FROM NOVEMBER - MARCH. THE FIRE STATION WILL HAVE 2 TOILETS, 2 SHOWERS, 4 SINKS, 1 WASHING MACHINE, 4 OUTDOOR SPIGOTS, 1 ICE MACHINE, FILL UP 1 FIRE TRUCK AND IRRIGATE 1 ACRE OF LANDSCAPE.

THE FACILITY WILL ALSO SUPPORT PERMITEE USE DURING NOVEMBER - APRIL. THERE WILL BE 2 PUBLIC TOILETS AND 3 SINKS TO SERVE UP TO 200 PEOPLE PER DAY.
