APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 71263 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 71263 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 24713 (revocable), 77730, 78072 and 78224, having the same place of use, shall not exceed 0.2535 cubic feet per second and 20.81 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 24713 (revocable), 77730 and 78072, having the same point of diversion, shall not exceed 0.2355 cubic feet per second and 10.2 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for commercial purposes for a pig farm on parcels identified by the Clark County Assessor as APN's 124-26-401-001, 124-26-401-002, 124-26-401-003, and 124-26-401-004.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second or 1.6 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 15, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




The water will be used to support the existing RC Farms operation. The water will also be used for domestic consumption on the existing living quarters on the ranch.
