#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place and manner of use of the waters of Jersey Hot Springs heretofore claimed under Proof of Appropriation of Water V05761 is issued with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to any determination of the waters of Jersey Hot Springs that may be made under adjudication proceedings pursuant to NRS 533.090 through 533.320.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This temporary permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which has customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the non-adjudicated right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.1337 cubic feet per second and 2.0 acre-feet annually.**


