APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 65733 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 65733 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Temporary Permits 78360T, 78361T, and 78362T, being fully supplemental, shall not exceed 31.0 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Temporary Permits 78359T, 78360T, 78361T, 78362T, and 78363T, having the same place of use, shall not exceed 131.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this temporary permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is issued for commercial purposes on the parcel identified by the Nye County Assessor as APN 44-531-05.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.33 cubic feet per second or 31.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



This temporary change application under permit number 65733 is submitted for E-T-T Enterprises, L.L.C., (ETT), owner of the Lakeside Casino and RV Park, to immediately come into compliance with NDWR regulations. This temporary application is only for changing the point of diversion as the place of use and manner of use would remain unchanged.

ETT owns the Middle well and the property that surrounds the Middle well (APN# 44-531-05); the subject of this temporary change application. This well currently supplies water to the Lakeside Casino and RV Park.

In addition to the Middle well, ETT owns two nearby wells (North well and South well) and the property that surrounds these two wells. These two wells currently supply water to the Lakeside Casino and RV Park and are subject of temporary change applications under permit numbers 65086, 65731, 65732, and 73518.

An application for permission to change the point of diversion is in preparation and shall follow this temporary change application to permanently change the point of diversion under permit number 65733 to the Middle well.

Please note that this temporary change application is associated with one of five permits: 65086, 65731, 65732, 65733, and 73518; these permits have a total combined duty of 131.0 afa.
