This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claims 606 and 630, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





Description of Proposed works – item #11:

Instream flows within the Truckee River from Derby Dam to the inlet of Pyramid Lake will be conducted in the river's natural stream channel, therefore, no other works are proposed.

Miscellaneous remarks - item 16:

As yet, the State Engineer's office has not created a map on DTR Claim 630.

All remaining water rights for Storey County APN's 004-061-02, 004-061-04, and 004-061-05, as assigned by District Court Decree #18562, are to be transferred by this application.

The Existing Place of Use for Permit 46755 (Certificate 11283) is shown on the map to accompany Application 46755, on file at the Nevada Division of Water Resources.
