APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of Lake Tahoe heretefore granted under Permit 71737 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 71737 and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of the water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada-Interstate Compact Commission or any subsequent allocation approved by both states. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water diverted from this source and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit is for service to one house located at Washoe County APN 130-332-04. Any future attempt to change the place of use of this permit will be denied. If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the source.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second or 0.56 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

December 14, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

December 14, 2010
