APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61572 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61572 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from all wells within the place of use and the amount of water used from each source.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 78697, 78701, 78703, 78976T, 78978T and 78980T shall not exceed 162.62 acre-feet annually for the commercial cultivation of lawn sod within the described place of use.

The total combined duty of water from this well under Permits 78697, 78703 and 78978T shall not exceed 122.62 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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Totalizing meters must be installed immediately on all wells within the place of use of this permit and any other wells providing water to the described place of use under this permit.

The approval of this application expires Temporary Permit 78696T.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0533 cubic feet per second or 28.64 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 25, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 25, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
