APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29402 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29402 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for the purpose of measuring water levels and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 24524, Certificate 8688; Permit 49436, Certificate 14457; Permits 61929, 72268, 73931, 73932, 73933, 74048, 74074, 74075, 77417, 78220, 78221 and 78887 shall not exceed 273.91 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second or 99.71 acre-feet annually.**



The point of diversion under Permit 29402, known as the "Eva Court Well", is not currently equipped to the extent that it can provide water service to the lots within the Sheridan Acres water system. While the Eva Court well is currently not in use, we are evaluating it as a site to replace the existing Eva Court well with a replacement well in the future.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

The purpose of this application is to change the existing "Point of Diversion to the existing Fire Station Well. Item 13 - 230' deep well with 10-inch dia. stainless steel casing, pump and motor and control building.
