APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and manner of use of a portion of the water as heretofore appropriated under Permit 23138, Certificate 6853, as it appears under the Clear Creek Decree Case 1020, State of Nevada, in District Court, Second Judicial District County of Ormsby July 22, 1872 is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The State Engineer retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **but not to exceed 7.5 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




