- The source of water is Underground George's Well (to be drilled)

- The amount of water applied for is 160 AFA, with an intermittent maximum withdrawal rate of 0.60 CFS
One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

9. Estimated cost of works: \$ 60,000, plus use of materials on hand, for well, pump, tank, and pipeline through phase 1

10. Estimated time required to construct works: 3 Years
