APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 69086 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 69086 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 13041, Certificate 4804, Permit 79036 and Permit 79037 shall not exceed 1382.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 3.5 cubic feet per second or 932.0 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre from any all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 16 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



186.4 acres within the SE¼SE¼ Section 13; NE¼NE¼, S½NE¼, SE¼ Section 24; NE¼ Section 25; all in T.3 S., R.60 E., MDM; SW¼SW¼ Section 18; W½NW¼, NW¼SW¼ Section 19; all in T.3 S., R.61 E., MDM. 186.4 acres will be irrigated within proposed Pivot #5 through Pivot #8, however a larger place of use is requested at this time since the acreage within each pivot is approximate and the locations of the pivots are not exact. The NE¼ of Section 25 is included to facilitate commingling of water with future changes to Well #5 to accommodate Pivot #4.

This application is being filed together with three other applications for Stewart-Nevada Enterprises, LLC. These four applications are in response to Item 5 on page 2 of the Settlement Agreement And Mutual Release between Stewart-Nevada Enterprises, LLC and Tracy Taylor, P.E., Nevada State Engineer signed in October 2009. Together the four applications propose to irrigate a total of 224 acres, with a duty not to exceed 1120 acre-feet annually.

The water under this application is to be commingled with an application to change Application 69085 being filed concurrently, for the irrigation of 186.4 acres and a total combined duty of 932.0 acre-feet annually.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

In the future, connection of Wells #6 and #8 to Well #5 to facilitate commingling of water is anticipated. Additional changes will be filed to accomplish this process.
