SNWA was formed in 1991 pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 277

1. The source of water is underground basin in Spring Valley, Hydrographic area 184, HQ, Meadow Creek 1


The water sought under this application will be placed to a beneficial use within the Spring Valley to irrigate lands owned by the SNWA.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

The point of diversion is the existing well under Permit 27378, Certificate 8357. A total of 640 acres is to be irrigated with water under this application and the application being filed concurrently, for a new well location in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, T.19N., R.66E., MDM. The underground rights will be partially supplemental to existing surface water rights. Use the PBU map on file under Permit 27378 to support the proposed Point of Diversion.
