#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 72207 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 72207 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 79640 and 79641 shall not exceed 320 acre-feet from any and all sources.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second or 320.0 acre-feet for the irrigation 80 acres and not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre from any and all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 13 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



A portion of Permit 72207 was withdrawn by letter dated December 30, 2009. This application is being filed to correct the point of diversion within the remaining place of use. Water under this permit will be commingled with that under Application to Change Permit 72208 and will not exceed 320 acre-feet annually.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Permit 72207 lists the point of diversion as being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26, T.39 1/2 N., R.21E., M.D.B. & M. while the supporting map shows the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 26. In addition the bearing on the Permit is incorrect when compared to the map. This application corrects the point of diversion to match the supporting map under Permit 72207.
