APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of waters of Warm Springs (aka Seven Devils Springs) as heretofore granted under Permit 10105, Certificate 2695 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 10105, Certificate 2695 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which has customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 4.93 acre-feet seasonally for the watering of 1044 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 25 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




