This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 281 Truckee River Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





Claim 281 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decree entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled "The United States of America, Plaintiff, vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al., Defendants", in Equity Docket A-3.

This application would allow refilling and maintenance of Manzanita Lake from the Orr Ditch as has been historically done. Since water is not in the Orr Ditch most of the year any more, water has been allocated to allow replacement (refilling) of lake water lost to evaporation during periods of unavailability of ditch water. Water has also been allocated to maintain the Lake during periods of Orr Ditch operation.


