APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 69042 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 69042 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water that may be pumped from Well #51 under Permits 71678, 77669, 79653, and 79717 shall not exceed 394.60 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Carson City's underground municipal permits within the Eagle Valley Hydrographic Basin (104) consisting of Permit 23672, Certificate 6471; Permit 23673, Certificate 6472; Permit 24986, Certificate 7366; Permit 25667, Certificate 9866; Permit 26581, Certificate 9622; Permit 26582, Certificate 9623; Permit 27314, Certificate 9871; Permit 27320, Certificate 9872; Permit 29002, Certificate 9904; Permit 29906, Certificate 9635; Permit 30441, Certificate 9878; Permits 36083, 36084, 47704, 48542, 59226, 59827, 60831, 60832, 60833, 60834, 61487, 61505, 61506, 61507, 61508, 66708, 66709, 68758, 69344, 69346, 70521, 70522, 70662, 71678, 71749, 77667, 77668, 77669, 78371, 79653, 79717 and 80166 shall not exceed 6,702.924 acre-feet annually. Permits 61505 through 61508 were issued for drought conditions only, per Order 1140, and are not additive to the above total combined duty term amount.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second or 34.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





ITEM 13 – Facilities at Proposed Point of Diversion

Carson City Well 51

A drilled well 820 feet deep with a 36" diameter surface casing. Two casing reductions reduce the case diameter to 14" at the well bottom, as reported under Well Log 97904. Well is reported by permittee to be equipped with a Goulds pump Model No. 10RJCLC Stage 4 Serial No. 159416, a submersible Hitachi 150HP Motor Serial No. K04A, and a Foxboro flowmeter Model No. 9112A DN300 Serial No. 166801T387.

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
