#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 16433, Certificate 4657, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16433, Certificate 4657, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 57763, Certificate 13970; Permit 57764, Certificate 13971; and Permit 79718 shall not exceed 79.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.008 cubic feet per second or 4.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





## Description to No. 11

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 420 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 30 H.P., 460 volt, 3 phase motor and pump, thence through a distribution system to 11.8 acres in the NW1/4 SW1/4 and 3.7 acres in the NE1/4 SW1/4 for a total of 15.5 acres all within Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. at the Masonic Memorial Gardens (cemetery) for landscaping purposes and an office, workshop, and storage building for domestic purposes, located within a portion of the N1/2 SW1/4 Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

**AGREEMENT**

This Agreement made and entered into this 8 day of MARCH, 2010 between MASONIC MEMORIAL GARDENS & MAUSOLEM (hereinafter "MMG&M) and RENO MASONIC TEMPLE ASSOCIATION (hereinafter Reno Masonic).

**RECITALS**

1. MMG&M is the owner of record of Certificated Permits 57763 and 57764. Such ground water rights are utilized to maintain the MMG&M cemetery and related facilities.

2. Reno Masonic is the owner of a portion of Permit 16433, Certificate 4657, and pursuant to Stipulation and Court Order in the action entitled Reno Masonic Temple Petitioner v. Tracy Taylor, P.E., Nevada State Engineer, et al. Case No. CV09-00793, Dept. 8 is required to move its portion of Permit 16433 Certificate 4657 to an existing point of diversion.


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and undertaking of the parties, they do agree as follows:

1. MMG&M does hereby authorize and allow Reno Masonic Temple Association the right and privilege of filing an application to change with the Nevada State Engineer, Permit 16433, Certificate 4657 to the well, the subject of Certificated Permits 57763 and 57764.

2. MMG&M does hereby agree, upon the State Engineer granting the application to change, to place the 4.0 acre feet annually of water to beneficial use within a reasonable time.


