

Water under this permit would be put to beneficial use by Pabco Building Products, LLC (Pabco). Pabco has an existing gypsum mining and milling operation within Black Mountain Hydrographic Basin; the gypsum is used to manufacture drywall board (gypsum board) for use in the housing industry. Due to a slowdown in housing construction drywall production at Pabco has seen a slowdown as well, however Pabco has a strong financial base and is forecasting renewed development and therefore a need for additional water supply in the future. Pabco estimates their need for additional water is between two to five years and would like to secure this water right.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

As such, this change application requests a duty of 250 afa, along with the change applications under existing permit Nos. 58051 and 61598 that each request a duty of 250 afa. The total combined duty requested under these three change applications is 250 afa.
