This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66785 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66785 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 72098 and 79948, having the same point of diversion, shall not exceed 0.326 cubic feet per second and 43.17 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66784, 66785, 77389, and 79948, being fully supplemental, shall not exceed 156.82 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66784, 66785, 72098, 74064, 77389, and 79948, having the same place of use, shall not exceed 178.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.




