#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 62947 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 62947 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

Temporary Permit 80021T is issued for the irrigation of a 130 acre pivot within the described place of use at 4.0 acre-feet per acre.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.726 cubic feet per second or 520.0 acre-feet annually, not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from any and all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:





Water is being moved from the non-supplemental portion of Permit 62947, which has a duty of 3.0 acre feet per acre. The pivot sprinkler will need approximately 4.0 acre feet per acre. This Temporary Application is being filed in conjunction with a Permanent Application also filed to change Permit 62947. This Temporary Application seeks a total diversion rate of 2.15 cfs (965 gpm) to provide an adequate diversion rate for effective pivot irrigation system irrigation. Existing non-supplemental acreage identified to be stripped under this application is in compliance with findings under the 1/12/2009 "Memorandum to File" under Permit 62947

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

It is recognized that the diversion rate sought under this Temporary Application, needed for efficient pivot system operation, is disproportionate to the acreage within the Existing Place of Use. It is understood that the disproportionate diversion rate amount will revert to the base permit upon issuance of a permit under the Permanent Application.
