APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This primary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of Musgrove Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 18198, Certificate 6278, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18198, Certificate 6278 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This primary permit is for storage of water only and is issued under the authority of NRS 533.440. The amount of water credited for storage will be based upon the data submitted. Any secondary application filed to put water to beneficial use will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

A monitoring plan that includes locations and types of measuring devices shall be submitted to and approved by the State Engineer and the Federal Water Master prior to any diversion of water under this permit. Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water diverted to storage under this permit and the records submitted to the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.354 cubic feet per second or 348.17 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


