APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

Upon cessation of pumping for commercial purposes at this place of use, water under this permit shall return to the source and no application to change or relinquishment will be allowed.

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 76653 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 76653 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 76652 and Permit 80116 shall not exceed 10.00 acre-feet annually.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.1553 cubic feet per second or 10.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Water will be used for augmenting natural precipitation to facilitate the growing of a cover crop for the commercial application of domestic septage, grease trap material and commercial sanitary wastewater at a nutrient deficient site. Application of water and waste materials are performed pursuant to the terms and provisions under Discharge Permit NEV2004511 issued by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

The proposed point of diversion is intended to provide increased production capacity and system redundancy. The total combined duty of water under this application and Permit 76652 shall not exceed 10 acre-feet annually.
