APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claims 57 and 221/222, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0133 cubic feet per second or 1.995 acre-feet as decreed, not exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet of land irrigated from any and/or all sources and is limited to the irrigation of 0.50 acre within the proposed place of use.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 25 2013

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Claims 057 and 221/222 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decreed entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled, "The United States of America, Plaintiff vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al., Defendants., in Equity Docket A-3.

2. The amount of water to be changed 2 acre-feet (DTR-221-2 = 0.59 acre-feet plus DTR-057 = 1.41 acre-feet)

I will be using irrigation water from the Steamboat Canal which will run from existing gate 42 off of Lone Tree Lane. The existing irrigation ditch running from existing gate 42 runs through the south edge of my property (APN# 041-120-10). I will install a gate valve on the southwest corner of my property from this irrigation ditch that will be used to irrigate field grass, trees and landscaping, and also will be used for a small pond located within this irrigated area.
