APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63513, Certificate 16637 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63513, Certificate 16637 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 75867 (Revocable) and 80236, having the same point of diversion and place of use shall not exceed 16.9 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 80236 is issued for commercial purposes within the described place of use, further identified by the Clark County Assessor as the 51.12 acre APN 122-09-610-001.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.



The project is a heavy equipment auction facility with an existing large equipment parking area and associated offices. Water is used for washing heavy equipment, dust control, and limited office staff. The facility has an immediate need for additional water to meet expanding operations, and increasing auction volume. A new permanent indoor auction building is proposed which will also require additional water.
