APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51544, Certificate 13802 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51544, Certificate 13802 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer within 30 days after the expiration of this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Temporary Permits 80259T and 80260T, having the same point of diversion and place of use, shall not exceed 0.276 cubic feet per second and 200.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

These Temporary Permits 80259T and 80260T are issued for construction purposes for a solar power plant for a period of one year. The total combined duty of Permits 17691, 21997, 51133, 51543, 51544, 52734, 52735, 54983 and 76210 is reduced to 453.37 acre-feet for a period of one year. The total withdrawal of this series of permits is limited to 567.7 acre-feet for a period of one year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0123 cubic feet per second or 8.9 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:





Silver State Solar is responsible for drilling their own well and their use of this water is subject to an agreement between LVVWD and Silver State Solar entered into on April 6, 2010. It is anticipated temporary change applications will be filed for construction water use and when the permanent water use is determined a permanent change application will be filed.
