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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 43475, Certificate 11313, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 43475, Certificate 11313, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0218 cubic feet per second sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 2000 sheep, but not to exceed 15.68 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



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

At the time predecessor of application submitted #43475, reliance upon indistinct aerial photo materials resulted in an error of calculated survey tie, placing the works in the wrong public land subdivision. Successor now seeks to correct the location, and to perpetuate a long-standing stock watering right. The BLM holds permit #58912 at the same site, using water for wild horse and wildlife purposes, and has been notified of this change application intent.
