APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of Negro Creek and Tributaries as heretofore granted under Permit 10487, Certificate 5042 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 10487, Certificate 5042 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water from Negro Creek under Permits 80453, 80454, 80455 and 80456 shall not exceed 1,812.53 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 473.68 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monitoring plan must be submitted and approved by the State Engineer prior to any diversion of water from this permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.873 cubic feet per second or 1149.2 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 30 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 30 2017

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 30 2017

Owner is currently coordinating with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) on proposed pipeline alignment and right-of-way crossing of BLM-administered property.
