APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 62955 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 62955 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 80526 and 80527 shall not exceed 236.40 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.246 cubic feet per second or 104.277 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 25 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



Water is being moved from the non-supplemental portion of Permit 62955, which has a duty of 3.0 acre feet per acre. The pivot sprinkler will need approximately 4.0 acre feet per acre.

Water under this change is to be commingled with water rights proposed to be changed under existing Permit 62954, providing for a combined total irrigated acreage of 59.1 acres.

Existing non-supplemental acreage identified to be stripped under this application is in compliance with findings under the 1/12/2009 "Memorandum to File" under Permit 62947


