This temporary permit, to change the manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee and Carson Rivers as set forth under the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decrees and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on November 15, 2011 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.



Item 16: Miscellaneous Remarks

The temporary change application is being filed to change the place and manner of use of water decreed under Truckee-Carson Irrigation District No. 9 United States of America v. Orr Water Ditch Co. in Equity No. A.3 Claim 3, and United States of America v. Alpine Land and Reservoir Company No. D-183 BRT.

This application is to account for TCID's alteration of water delivery practices to the Applicant that reduced water deliveries to Applicant's lands. This transfer allows Applicant to recover "TCID's unilateral reduced water delivery" while working towards resolution with the District.

This and the accompanying Temporary Change Application are to move 134.32 AF from 44.923 acres within Applicant's Ranch. When changing the manner of use from irrigation to a storage, the water allocation reduces 3.5 AF/acre to 2.99 AF/acre. By multiplying 44.923 acres by 2.99 AF/acre the AF generated is 134.32 AF.

Previously, the Nevada Division of Water Resources informed our consultant that 4.0 AF/acre is the amount required to apply water to the "reservoir" and canal to cover evaporation losses on the stored water. The reservoir and canal have a surface area of 33.58 acres, which multiplied by 4 AF/acre equals 134.32 AF.
