This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 26, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second or 0.5 acre-feet as decreed for the irrigation of 0.125 acres within the proposed place of use and not to exceed 4.00 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 30 2013

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 30 2016

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 30 2016
