This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of Burnt Canyon Creek & Delmue Springs 1, 2 & 3, as heretofore appropriated under Proof V04369 as it appears in the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Judgement and Decree in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to The Waters of Camp Valley Creek, Eagle Valley Creek, Panaca Big Spring, Clover Valley Wash, Meadow Valley Wash and their Tributaries in Lincoln and Clark Counties, Nevada in the Seventh Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Lincoln, dated June 9, 1999 is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.03775 cubic feet per second or 7.55 acre-feet as decreed.**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





3. Delmue Spring No. 3. Lot 2, Section 19, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at the point from which the W^{1/4} corner of said Section 19 bears S. 86° 06' 40" W., a distance of 817.7 feet.
4. Burnt Canyon Creek Diversion (Delmue) Dam No. 1. NE^{1/4} NW^{1/4}, NW^{1/4} NE^{1/4} Section 24, T.5N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E^{1/4} corner of said Section 24 bears S. 57° 19' 56" E., a distance of 3,120.24 feet.
5. Burnt Canyon Creek Diversion (Delmue) Dam No. 2. NE^{1/4} NE^{1/4} Section 30, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 30 bears N. 85° 24' 48" E., a distance of 692.65 feet.
