APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place and manner of use of a portion of Claim 23, Claim 23A, Claim 35, Claim 44, Claim 67 and Claim 89 of the waters of the Walker River Decree as appearing in "Docket in Equity" C-125 file April 5, 1936, in the District of the United States of America in and for the District of Nevada, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit is for the consumptive use portion only, being 4.122 cubic feet per second, and fully abrogates 7.745 cubic feet per second associated with 646.16 acres under Claims 23, 23A, 35, 44, 67 and 89. The remaining portion, being 3.623 cubic feet per second, will remain in the river for use at the discretion of the Federal Water Master.

The dates of priority of this permit remain the same as Claims 23, 23A, 35, 44, 67 and 89 of the Walker River Decree, and the period of use of this permit is limited to that portion of the irrigation season when the respective portions of the permit are in priority to receive water.

This permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions of the Walker River Decree C-125 and subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the U.S. Board of Water Commissioners, the Walker River Decree Court and the State Engineer.

This permit is issued subject to the stipulation of June 28, 2013, between the National Fish & Wildlife Foundation and the Walker River Irrigation District. This permit is also issued subject to the stipulation and conveyance agreement of October 2, 2013, between the National Fish & Wildlife Foundation and the Walker River Paiute Tribe.

This permit is expressly contingent on the payment of the operation and maintenance charges that are properly assessed and come due the same as if the water rights were still appurtenant to the agricultural land from which they were transferred pursuant to NRS 533.370(1)(b).

Daily records shall be kept of the amount of water from this source passing the original point of diversion, the amount that reaches the Wabuska Gage and the amount that reaches Walker Lake. These records shall be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 4.122 cubic feet per second, not to exceed 2,003.10 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 28 **2015**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Applicant intends to manage conveyance of water from Wabuska Gauge to Walker Lake under an agreement to be negotiated with the Walker River Paiute Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs that addresses the operation of Weber Dam and the Walker River Indian Irrigation Project.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Applicant will withdraw 646.16 acres of associated supplemental ground water rights in the existing place of use (Item 8) as a condition of exercise following approval by the Nevada State Engineer and the U.S. District Court. Applicant acknowledges that the amount approved for change in Item 2 will not conflict with existing rights as required by law.
