APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29694, Certificate 9087, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29694, Certificate 9087, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2 inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The Permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 17654, Certificate 5250; Permit 26872, Certificate 8431; Permit 29694, Certificate 9087; Permit 35814, Certificate 10284; Permits 64260, 64261, 79547, 80789 and 80790 shall not exceed 1076.11 acre-feet annually.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.4345 cubic feet per second or 200.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 30 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed by a pipeline to a reservoir within the NE 1/4 of Section 26, T28N, R45E, M.D.B.&M., where it is used for mining purposes. The well for which the existing water right is for, is at a further distance form the usage point than the proposed point of diversion, thus less condusive to water usage for the application. It is believed that the transfer of the portion of water rights will better suit the needs of the application.
