This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 68666, which changed the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Claims 177/204 and 178/262, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is issued subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and State Engineer.



Permit No. 74995 is the only water right permit supporting the Verdi Lake project. This application would allow for temporary use of 35.0 acre feet of Truckee River water at Verdi Lake. The gate valve at the lake developed a leak, necessitating complete drainage of the lake in order to make repairs. There is no undelivered duty remaining under Permit No. 74495 with which to refill the lake for this season.

The proposed point of diversion is Verdi Power Ditch, per Orr Ditch Decree.


