This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees and a portion of Permit 69656 which changed the place of use of a portion of the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decrees and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 30.31 acre-feet as decreed.**


Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: **Filed Under 62742 on June 25, 1998**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **February 12 2017**


