#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of Claim 715 of the Carson River as heretofore granted under the Carson River Final Decree No. D-183, in the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said final decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion prior to any diversion of water and accurate measurements kept of water placed to beneficial use.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water diverted from this induction well and all of the other Carson City Municipal Induction Wells and all of the Lyon County / Dayton Utilities Induction Wells and the records submitted to the State Engineer and the Federal Water Master on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter. The amount of water pumped for use within Carson City Utilities Service Area and the amount used within the Lyon County Utilities Service Area must be recorded and submitted as separate amounts.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The approval of this application totally abrogates Claim 715 of the Carson River Final Decree.

The design of any induction well constructed under this permit must be approved by the State Engineer.



The Interlocal Contract was recorded in Lyon County on January 31, 2007. The Item 2 diversion rate 0.5 cfs represents the delivery allowed under Carson River Temporary Restraining Order Proof No. 0225, not including the allowed additional 15% ditch loss (see attached TRO reference copy as provided by Federal Watermaster's Office).
