This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 15227, Certificate 4828, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Claim 492, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

Water will be diverted from the Truckee River into the Washoe Power Ditch through existing dams and diversion structure.


Water will then be transported to the place of use via the Washoe Power Ditch and used for irrigation purposes as decreed.
