This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of Crystal Springs, as heretofore appropriated under Proof V01794 as appears in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Pahranaagat Lake and its Tributaries, in the District Court of the Tenth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Lincoln, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **October 1, 2012** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.


