APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Salmon Falls Creek (aka Salmon River), as heretofore appropriated under Permit 12888, Certificate 4823, that allowed a change in the point of diversion and place of use from lands located within the State of Nevada to lands located within the State of Idaho. Permit 12888 changed the point of diversion and place of use of Proof V-01413 as appears in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights In and To the Waters of Salmon River and Its Tributaries, In Elko County, Nevada, in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Elko. This permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and subject to the Salmon River Settlement Agreement, dated May 20, 1952 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.



Water was originally decreed under Claim No. V-01413 of the Salmon River Decree (Nevada) and subject to the provisions of the Salmon River Settlement Agreement dated May 20, 1952. These rights were subsequently moved into Idaho by Application No. 12888, Certificate 4823, filed to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of "The Salmon River".

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1. The source of water is Salmon Falls Creek (AKA Salmon River)
Name of stream, lake, underground, spring or other sources.
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 cfs
Second feet, acre-feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.
3. The water to be used for Mineral Exploration
Irrigation, power, mining, commercial, etc. If for stock, state number and kind of animals. Must limit to one major use
4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a found section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)
The SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 45 N.; R/64E, M.D.B. & M. or at the point from which the SE corner of said Section 20 bears S.70 degrees E. a distance of 2,100 feet.

The existing point of diversion under the Salmon River Decree is described as the current stream channel where a series of dams was used to spread water over the land. The point of diversion under Permit 12888, Certificate 4823 is described as being within the SE1/4NE1/4 Section 20, T.45N., R64E, M.D.B. & M. or at the point from which the E1/4 of said Section 20 bears S.34 degrees 53'E. a distance of 986.9 feet.

Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24 all located within T.45N., R.63E., M.D.B. & M and within Sections 17 and 20, T.45N., R.64E., M.D.B. & M.

8. Existing place of use (Describe by legal subdivisions. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.)

See attached description (Certificate 4823) for the Idaho place of use. Water from the Salmon River is stored in the Salmon Falls Creek Reservoir where the water is stored for distribution within the area served by the Salmon River Canal Co., LTD. Therefore, the small amount of water that will be withdrawn will not have any noticeable affect on the irrigated acreage in Idaho with water administered by the Salmon River Canal Co.,

9. Proposed use will be from November 1 to October 31 of each year.

10. Existing use permitted from As Decreed to As Decreed of each year.
