APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 69069 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 69069 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66815, 66816, 69069, 69070, 78657, 81661T and 81662T shall not exceed 3,200 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

All surface waters must be used for irrigation prior to the use of any of the supplemental ground water.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second or 640.0 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



The applicant currently controls permits 66815, 66816, 69069, 69070 and 78657 that are combined for a duty of 3,200 acre feet annually for the irrigation of 800 acres. The wells under permits 66815, 66816, 69069 and 69070 will not produce sufficient amounts of water to irrigate the total acreage. The applicant wishes to drill two other wells to supplement the existing wells in order to place the maximum amount of water to beneficial use under these permits. There is currently a driller that is available to drill the additional wells. We are filing this temporary application in order to take advantage of the drillers availability to drill the wells and also to use the waters under this application this growing season. Once the amount of water obtained from the new well can be determined, permanent applications to change will be filed for the new wells.
